All Expense Paid Trip to Washington D.C.

To qualify, contestants must (a) be high school juniors, (b) receive their local phone service from Range, and (c) have parental authorization.

Students attending the Youth Tour will gain a first-hand look at the telecommunications industry and receive education on government processes. Students will also have an opportunity to visit famous historical sites in our nation’s capitol.
